Re: **City Council Bill 11-0751 - Sale of Property - Former Bed of Eager Street**

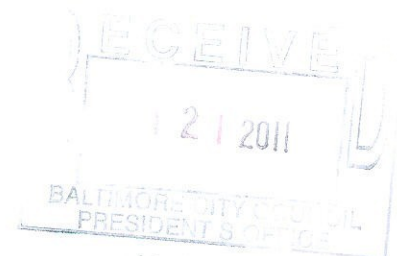
The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0751, which was introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcel of land known as the former bed of Eager Street, extending from Chester Street Easterly 266.6 feet, more or less, to Collington Avenue, and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

This bill authorizes the sale of property that has companion opening (City Council Bill 11-0749) and closing (City Council Bill 11-0750) ordinances related to the site assembly for the construction of the New East Baltimore School, a public charter school serving grades PreK-8 in the East Baltimore Development Incorporated (EBDI) section of the city adjacent to the Johns Hopkins medical campus.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 11-0751.
