The Department of Planning has received City Council Bill #09-0376 for the purpose of providing a Supplementary Federal Fund Capital Appropriation in the amount of \$1,590,000 to the Department of Transportation (Account #9950-904663-9508), to provide funding for the purchase of a ferry boat and to make pier improvements.

A grant from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act will fund these purchases and targeted improvements will support Baltimore’s Inner Harbor Connector ferry boat operation. Moreover, this effort is consistent with Baltimore City’s Comprehensive Master Plan in that it supports Goal 3, Objective:1 under the Earn category to improve access to jobs and mitigate traffic congestion.
