AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Zoning – Conditional Use Housing for the Elderly –
6400 East Pratt Street 200 Kane Street (Block 6333, Lot 28A)
and 6424 East Pratt Street (Block 6333, Lot 28B)

FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of housing for the elderly on the property known as 6400 East Pratt Street 200 Kane Street (Block 6333, Lot 28A) and 6424 East Pratt Street (Block 6333, Lot 28B), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of housing for the elderly on the property known as 6400 East Pratt Street 200 Kane Street (Block 6333, Lot 28A) and 6424 East Pratt Street (Block 6333, Lot 28B), as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-1004(2) and 14-102, subject to the ~~condition that the~~ following conditions:

1. The maximum number of resident clients is 150, excluding staff.
2. The housing for the elderly ~~complies~~ must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;

5 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
6 after the date it is enacted.
