<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Repeal of Ordinance 03-613 – University of Maryland BioPark Planned Unit Development

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of repealing Ordinance 03-613, as amended by Ordinance 11-477, which designated certain properties as a Business Planned Unit Development known as University of Maryland BioPark; and providing for a special effective date.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – This bill serves as a companion bill to City Council Bill 19-0398 as well as City Council Bill 19-0399. Together, the three bills allow for the area known as the University of Maryland BioPark to be zoned under the new BSC zone designation, established under the Transform Baltimore comprehensive rezoning plan as Bio-Science Campus Zones.
