12	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the General Fund Balance
13	(\$662,871), Motor Vehicle Fund Balance (\$101,650), Waste Water Utility Fund Balance
14	(\$35,822), and Water Utility Fund Balance (\$76,657) in excess of the revenue relied on by the
15	Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
16	2006.
17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On September 14, 2005, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$877,000 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works (Account #9916-194-191) as a Supplementary Capital Fund Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2006, to provide funding for a fuel system upgrade. The source of revenue for this appropriation is from the General Fund Balance (\$662,871), Motor Vehicle Fund Balance (\$101,650), Waste Water Utility Fund Balance (\$35,822), and Water Utility Fund Balance (\$76,657) in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.
