12	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in
13	accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either
14	public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property
15	known as South of Sidney Avenue, rear of 2451 Sidney Avenue (Block 7445, Lot 109), and
16	more particularly described as follows:
17	The subject parcel (Block 7445, Lot 109) is an unimproved lot. The site is
18	located on the east side of Annapolis Road, north of Waterview Avenue in the
19	Westport area of Baltimore City,
20	containing 2,450 square feet, more or less, of unimproved land, this property being no longer
21	needed for public use.
