City Council** 13 § 1. Legislative Department; qualification and salary of members. 14 15 (b) Qualifications. Members of the City Council, except the President whose qualifications are provided for 16 in Section 3, shall be citizens of the United States, [above the age of twenty-one] AT 17 LEAST 18 years OLD, and registered voters OF BALTIMORE CITY. They also shall be 18 residents of the districts the members have been chosen to represent for at least [one] 1 19 year next preceding their election, except as provided in Section 7(e), and during their 20 term of office. 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment to the City 22 Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or 23 rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form 24 specified by the City Solicitor. 25
