10	that Ordinance to designate certain properties a Business Planned Unit Development known as
11	Lighthouse Point is rescinded.

13	amended by Ordinance 96-096, has no impact on those grants and obligations memorialized by
14	that certain Pedestrian Promenade Easement Agreement dated October 16, 2002, recorded among
15	the Land Records of Baltimore City, at Liber F.M.C. No. 8603, Folio 0656, on November 14,
16	2006, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Pedestrian Promenade Agreement dated
17	May 16, 2012, and as further amended by that certain Second Amendment to Pedestrian
18	Promenade Easement Agreement and Grant of Easement Rights dated November 8, 2017,
19	recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City, at Liber M.B. No. 19873, Folio 105, on
20	January 26, 2018.
21	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
22	enacted.
