Re: **City Council Bill 13-0244 – Baltimore City Landmark List – Canton Methodist Episcopal Church**

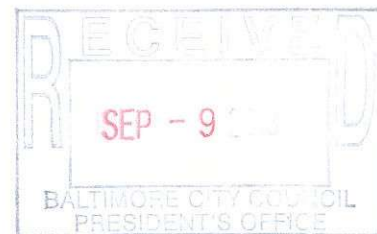
The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0244, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Canton Methodist Episcopal Church, 1000 South Ellwood Avenue, as a historical landmark.

This bill, if enacted, would add the property known as 1000 South Ellwood Street—the Canton Methodist Episcopal Church—to the Baltimore City Landmark List. The subject property is located in the Canton neighborhood and is located in an R-8 Zoning District.
