7	repairs, \$50,000 to Service 647 (Youth and Adult Sports) to provide capital planning support
8 9	for Upton Boxing, and \$800,000 to Service 648 (Community Recreation Centers) to expand after-school programming; and providing for a special effective date.

16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$905,000 in excess of the revenue
17	relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for
18	Fiscal Year 2025.
19	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
20	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.
21	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
22	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated or is for a new program that could
23	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
24	On October 2, 2024, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
25	Council.
