BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in 12 13 accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the Comptroller of Baltimore City may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in 14 the property located at 411 East Old Cold Spring Lane (Block 5070A, Lot 022), containing 4.867 15 acres, more or less, as improved by a 2 story building containing 67,000 square feet, more or less, 16 having formerly served as Guilford Elementary School, this property being no longer needed for 17 18 public use. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance 19 20 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor. SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 21 22 enacted.
