INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 18-0314 introduced by Councilmembers Clarke and Stokes. This bill is being introduced at the request of The Johns Hopkins University.

PURPOSE

This ordinance will repeal Ordinance 87-1171, which designated certain property as a Residential Planned Unit Development known as the Wyman Park Medical Center Joint Use Facility with The Johns Hopkins University.

BRIEF HISTORY

This bill will repeal a PUD that requires an outdated building program originally conceived in 1987 that is no longer under consideration by the owner. With the approval of the city's comprehensive zoning update in 2016, the EC-2 zoning of the property is sufficient to allow for new development on the site.
