I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09-0424 introduced by Council President Rawlings Blake on behalf of the Administration (Department of Housing and Community Development).

The purpose of the Bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as Block 530, Lot 43/46 (the Mayfair Theater Dressing Rooms) and no longer needed for public use.

The former Mayfair Theater Dressing Rooms is a two-story brick structure that is attached to the former Mayfair Theater (506/514 N. Howard Street), and is identified as Disposition Lot #6 in the Market Center Urban Renewal Area. City Council Bill 09-0424, if approved, would authorize the sale of the former Mayfair Theater Dressing Rooms property. No utilities or other interests would be affected by the proposed sale.

The Department of Public Works supports passage of City Council Bill 09-0424.
