1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Baltimore City Landmark List – Bolton Square**

3 FOR the purpose of designating Bolton Square, 1400 to 1420 Mason Street, 300 to 310 West
4 Lafayette Avenue, 236 to 250 West Lafayette Avenue, and 1401 to 1421 Jordon Street, as a
5 historical landmark.

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

15 **Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s**

16 **§ 12-23. BOLTON SQUARE.**

17 **BOLTON SQUARE, 1400 TO 1420 MASON STREET, 300 TO 310 WEST LAFAYETTE AVENUE, 236**
18 **TO 250 WEST LAFAYETTE AVENUE, AND 1401 TO 1421 JORDON STREET.**

19 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
20 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
21 Ordinance.

22 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
23 after the date it is enacted.
