Recitals

- 13 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$5,982,755 in excess of the revenue
- relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for
- 15 Fiscal Year 2024.
- 16 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of 17 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2024 was formulated.
- 18 The source of this additional revenue is Income Tax State Collected.
- <u>This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the</u>

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 1 \$5,982,755 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works - Service 663 2 (Waste Removal and Recycling) as a Supplementary Special Revenue General Fund Operating 3 Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to provide funding for unbudgeted contractual collection 4 services and tipping fees beyond budgeted amount. The source of revenue for this appropriation 5 6 is Income Tax - State Collected in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 7 8 2024.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 10 enacted.
