I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 11-0745 introduced by Councilmembers Stokes and Branch at the request of Calhoun- Laurens, Inc.

The purpose of this bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for East Baltimore Midway to revise Exhibits 1 and 4 to reflect the change in zoning, upon approval by separate ordinance, for 2315-2317 Cecil Avenue; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed the amendments to the Urban Renewal Plan for East Baltimore Midway and determined there would be no negative impact to parking in that area as a result of this amendment. The Parking Authority will have a member of our staff readily available to other City agencies and or work-groups on any parking activity within this Urban Renewal Plan area.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 11-0745
