4 FOR the purpose of altering certain membership requirements for the Board of Directors for the
5 South Baltimore Gateway Community Impact District Management Authority; amending
6 certain term limits for certain members of the Board of Directors; and providing for a special
7 effective date.

13 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
14 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

16 **Article 14. Special Benefits Districts**

17 **Subtitle 19. South Baltimore Gateway Community Impact District**

1 **§ 19-6. Board of Directors.**

2 (d) *Appointment.*

3 (2) *Council President appointees.*

4 [2 members of the Board shall be appointed by the City Council President.]

5 THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE BALTIMORE CITY
6 COUNCIL WHO REPRESENT THE COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS OVERLAPPING WITH THE
7 BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTH BALTIMORE GATEWAY COMMUNITY IMPACT DISTRICT TO
8 SERVE AS EX OFFICIO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

9 (f) *Terms.*

10 (2) *Term limits.*

11 (i) *IN GENERAL.*

12 The Bylaws may specify a maximum number of consecutive terms that an
13 appointed member may serve.

14 (ii) *EXEMPTIONS.*

15 THE BYLAWS MAY NOT ESTABLISH TERM LIMITS FOR APPOINTED MEMBERS IF
16 THE MEMBER IS AN ELECTED OFFICIAL AS DEFINED UNDER ARTICLE 8, § 2-8
17 {“DEFINITIONS - ELECTED OFFICIAL.”} OF THE CODE.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
19 enacted.
