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**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**1      Zoning – Conditional Use Conversion of a Single-Family Dwelling to 2 Dwelling Units in**  
**2      the R-7 Zoning District – Variance – 220 North Culver Street**

**3      FOR** the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the conversion of a single-family  
**4      dwelling unit to 2 dwelling units in the R-7 Zoning District on the property known as 220**  
**5      North Culver Street (Block 2275A, Lot 135), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat;**  
**6      granting a variance regarding certain bulk regulations (lot size area); and providing for a**  
**7      special effective date.**

**13     SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
**14     permission is granted for the conversion of a single-family dwelling unit to 2 dwelling units in**  
**15     the R-7 Zoning District on the property known as 220 North Culver Street (Block 2275A,**  
**16     Lot 135) as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with  
17     Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 5-201(a) and 9-701(2), subject to the condition that the property  
18     complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.**

**19     SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That pursuant to the authority granted by  
20     §§ 5-305(a) and 5-308 of Article 32 - Zoning, permission is granted for a variance from the  
21     requirements of §§ 9-401 (Table 9-401: Rowhouse and Multi-Family Residential Districts - Bulk  
22     and Yard Regulations) and 9-703(d), as the minimum lot size requirement for 2 dwelling units in  
23     the R-7 Zoning District is 2,200 square feet and the existing lot area size is approximately 1,650  
24     square feet, requiring a variance of 25%.



1       **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That as evidence of the authenticity of the  
2       accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning  
3       Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council  
4       shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;  
5       and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the  
6       Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of  
7       Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and  
8       the Zoning Administrator.

9       **SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
10      after the date it is enacted.

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
