The Department of Planning has received City Council Bill No. 08-0072R for the purpose of requesting the members of the Baltimore City Board of Liquor License Commissioners to report to the City Council on the procedures utilized to enforce the prohibition against the existence of liquor establishments within 300 feet of a church or of a school and to consider the feasibility of requesting the Honorable Chairs and Members of the Baltimore City Senate and House Delegations to the 2009 Maryland General Assembly to introduce legislation to increase the distance of the prohibition.

The Department of Planning has no objection to this legislation and supports further study of the option to increase the distance from which a licensed liquor establishment may be located in relation to a church or school.
