

Dear Mr. President and Members:

The Baltimore City Environmental Control Board (ECB) has been requested to review City Council Bill # 23-0427, Baltimore Police Department – Trauma-Informed Care Training. The purpose of the bill is to add the Baltimore Police Department to the list of City agencies who are required to designate 2 agency staff members to participate in certain trauma-informed training and activities.

The ECB is an independent administrative hearing board that adjudicates contested environmental citations. Environmental citations are issued by various City agencies for violations listed under Article 1, § 40-14.

The ECB has no objection to the passage of this bill.
