II. Special Permits and Conditions

A. Special Permits:

a. The business at 141 W. [hamburg] HAMBURG Street (at the time of this restatement, Jack’s Liquor Store) is eligible for up to 2 special permits[.], [Permits are] valid 7 days a week from [9am-] 9 A.M. TO midnight.

B. THE BALTIMORE STATION, 140 W. WEST STREET, IS ELIGIBLE FOR 6 SPECIAL PERMITS, VALID 7 DAYS A WEEK FROM 9 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
