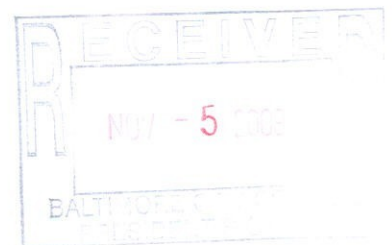


I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09-0404 introduced by Council President, Stephanie Rawlings-Blake, at the request of The Administration (Department of Housing and Community Development).

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain properties that are known as 2306 – 2308 Riggs Avenue and 2950 – 2966 Mosher Street and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. reviewed the proposed legislation and determined that there would be no operational or fiscal impact to any administered parking programs for on-street parking activity and/or City-owned off-street parking facilities. If there are any changes to the land use, then the buyer of the property will need to file for a change in land use of said property.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 09-0404.



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
