4. Victor Tervalva confirmed that the Law Department stands by its written report.
5. Chairman Costello explained the proposed amendments to change the address for the new license location. Victor Tervalva noted that the Law Department does not object to the amendments.
6. Councilwoman Clarke asked why the licensee wants to exchange the Class B-D-7 license for a Class A-7 license. The Class B-D-7 license is for taverns and the Class A-7 license is for package goods sales. A package goods license is more appropriate for the planned use at the location.
7. Al Barry testified regarding the planned use for the license.
8. The Committee considered and adopted the amendments.
