Re: **City Council Bill 12-0134 – Baltimore City Landmark List: Public Interiors – St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Church**

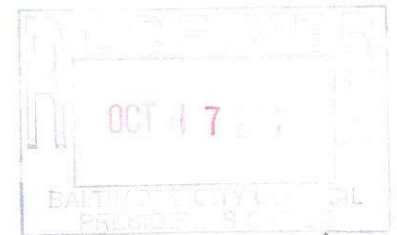
The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 12-0134, which was introduced for the purpose of designating St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Church, 1920 Saint Paul Street, as a historical landmark: public interior.

This bill would designate the public interior of the St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Church, located at 1920 Saint Paul Street, as a Baltimore City Landmark. The exterior of St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Church has already been designated a Baltimore City Landmark; and it is the understanding of the Department of Housing and Community Development that the public interior of the structure meets all the criteria for the City's Landmark designation.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 12-0134.
