I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 10-0605 introduced by Councilmember Cole.

The Urban Renewal Plan for Upton was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 70-794 and last amended by Ordinance 10-296.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed the amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Upton to extend the life of the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

It has been determined there would be no negative impact to the parking in the Upton area as a direct result of this amendment. The Parking Authority would be readily available to other City Agencies, work-groups and/or Developers to assist with any on-street parking activity associated with this amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 10-0605.
