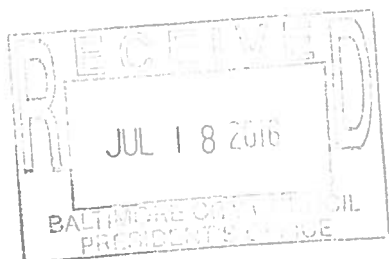

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0706 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill proposes to add a provision to the City's law regarding speed cameras that State law requires local jurisdictions to include in their local laws. The City's speed camera law currently requires the City to comply with State law so the City has been adhering to the requirements of the language being added by this bill. This bill merely specifically states in the law that which the City already does but did not have the language restated in its local law.

Since the added language is required by the State law, the Law Department approves Council Bill 16-0706 for form and legal sufficiency.
