Re: **City Council Bill 18-0243 Urban Renewal – Poppleton - Amendment**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 18-0243, for the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan (URP) for Poppleton to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill would An amendment to the URP for Poppleton is necessary to reauthorize the Plan's powers of acquisition and condemnation for another four years, until December 31, 2022 so that these actions may legally continue, in compliance with § 12-105.1 of the Real Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. Without this reauthorization, the authority to acquire property under the Plan will terminate on December 31, 2018.

The renewal of the acquisition authority is important to assist with addressing the concentration of blight and facilitating the rehabilitation and reinvestment of the neighborhood in accordance with the Poppleton URP.

The Department of Housing and Community Development strongly encourages the passage of City Council Bill 18-0243.
