Re: **City Council Bill 12-0052 – Baltimore City Landmark List – Shelley House**

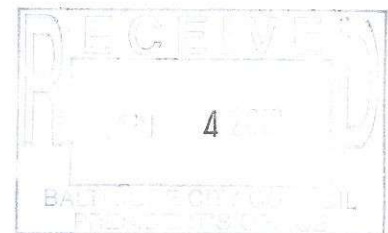
The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 12-0052, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Shelley House, 3849 Roland Avenue, as a historical landmark.

This bill would designate the Shelley House, located at 3849 Roland Avenue, as a Baltimore City Landmark. It is the understanding of the Department of Housing and Community Development that Shelley House has historic significance because it is the oldest residential building made of reinforced concrete in the City of Baltimore.
