BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either 12 public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property. 13 known as 1125 North Calvert Street (Ward 11, Section 12, Block 498, Lot 10) and more 14 particularly described as follows: 15 The subject parcel (Block 498, Lot 10) is an improved lot with an 18,093 square-16 foot structure known as the Inn at Government House. The City-owned property 17 will be used for the adaptive reuse as a 17-room boutique-style bed and breakfast 18 with ancillary restaurant and event space. 19 This property being no longer needed for public use. 20 SECTION 2.
