

The Baltimore City Fire Department has no objections for **City Council Bill #22-0219 – Planned Unit Development – Amendment – Harbor Point**. The location must comply with all applicable codes, ordinances, and laws and shall be required to obtain all required approvals. The location shall comply with the Building, Fire, and Related Codes of Baltimore City 2020 Edition (As Enacted by Ord. 15-547, and Last Amended by Ord. 18-1830) and applicable Maryland laws.

The above does not negate any requirements for submission of plans to the Office of the Fire Marshal for review of construction, Fire Detection/Notification/Suppression Systems, and Automatic Sprinkler installation. The location may be subject to an annual fire inspection and/or permits from the Office of the Fire Marshal.
