## Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
  - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
  - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
  - III. Made city government services more efficient;
  - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
  
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
  - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
  - II. Population Growth;
  - III. Labor and Employment;
  - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
  - V. Community Benefit

## Commitments and Expenditures

At the end of January 2023, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$555.6 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through January 2023, about \$79.7 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 14% of the current commitments and 12% of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation.

## Performance Measures and Metrics

As previously noted, many agencies are still fully designing and implementing programs; therefore, data are limited. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available. The Recovery Office anticipates including some targets and benchmarks for agency performance during the FY23 period of performance. In the interim, the report includes narrative information on agency accomplishments to date. In addition, the Recovery Office is working with university partners and funded agencies and organizations in the coming months to establish equity-related targets based on best practices and available baseline data.

### *Population, Labor & Employment Growth*

Council legislation requires critical performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to population growth. No data source exists that would demonstrate population growth on a monthly basis. In addition, some ARPA funding may be used for programs and initiatives that could result

in population growth. However, such instances would be anecdotal in nature and cannot be positively correlated to ARPA.

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has awarded ARPA funding for significant investments into small businesses and nonprofits with a prioritization on minority and women-led organizations. As previously noted, data are limited as programs are being implemented. The results of efforts to date are included in the Economic Recovery Fund portion of the report.

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs continues to make significant progress in the awarding of ARPA funds, the monitoring of agency and organization's progress, and in the accountability and transparency in the use of these funds. # Commitments

## Recovery Office Accomplishments

Since the last report, the Mayor’s Office of Recovery Programs hosted two training sessions on Internal Controls and Single Audits with city agencies, quasi-government agencies, and nonprofit ARPA grantees. Over 160 participants attended the internal controls training, and over 110 participants attended the single audit training. A third session was hosted to answer specific questions that awardees had about compliance with their ARPA grant award.

The Recovery Office previously announced grant awards to nonprofits in four rounds. As of January 2023, nonprofit awardees reported \$1.2M in expenditures—with the first disbursements occurring in November 2022. See Table 1 for information on total disbursements to nonprofits. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofits are as follows:

- Bikur Cholim is taking a holistic approach to addressing the health needs of Baltimore City residents. Since the start of their project in October, Bikur Cholim has provided food assistance to 119 households, financial assistance for medical needs to 10 households, and COVID-19 vaccines to 206 individuals.
- Chesapeake Shakespeare Company has reserved free admission tickets to their spring production, as well as covered transportation costs for 2541 Baltimore City Public School students.
- Baltimore Safe Haven has housed 21 individuals, 100% of which are engaged in at least one in-house program, including HIV testing, harm reduction, professional development/job readiness, and transportation assistance. Additionally, Baltimore Safe Haven has facilitated four individuals transitioning from Baltimore Safe Haven Housing to stable housing.
- Since October of 2022, Soccer Without Borders has provided tutoring services to 135 youth, with a focus on students who are English Language Learners.


Finally, in January 2023, the Recovery Office submitted the required quarterly project and expenditure report covering the period of July 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

# Subawardee Accomplishments

## Economic Recovery Fund

Eight hundred twenty-four grants, totaling \$15,980,775, have been awarded from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (the complete list of organizations is in the appendix). The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded through January 2023. Please note that some nonprofit organizations funded by BCF used their headquarters address on funding applications. The map may not specifically depict the location where services are rendered, however, sub-awardees provide services to a wide variety of neighborhoods across the City.

### **Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance**

BCF made one additional payment to a 2022 Nonprofit Relief Fund grantee. The final grantee was paid \$32,266.08 via electronic funds transfer in January 2023.

A 1-year survey was shared with the recipients of the Fall 2021 round of the Nonprofit Relief Fund on December 23, 2022. Their responses were aggregated and shared with MORP on January 31, 2023. Of the 231 grantees from the first round, 91 nonprofits responded. One year after being awarded, respondents experienced an average of 3.3% increase in revenue. Notably, 47% of respondents received no other financial assistance outside of the Nonprofit Relief Fund.

BCF has completed all payments for the Nonprofit Relief Fund.

### ***Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance***

BDC is in the process of completing grant agreements and processing payments for the 274 small businesses receiving round 2 grant awards. In addition, BDC's 13 community-based technical assistance partners continuously perform outreach and engagement activities with the small business community.

### ***Visit Baltimore Economic Recovery Assistance***

Visit Baltimore has fully expended its award and will not have a new status update until the 12-month follow-up survey, which will be conducted in April 2023.

### ***Family League Economic Recovery Assistance***

The Family League of Baltimore City has expended its \$2 million grant award and disbursed funds to 182 child daycare providers. Subsequently, FLBC has completed reporting on the performance of its beneficiaries.

## **City Agencies Accomplishments**

### ***Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)***

Requisitions were approved for playground projects at Radecke Park, Indiana Ave., Silverbell, and Shipley Hill, and BCRP is in the process of getting Purchase Orders for those projects. BCRP is working with procurement to process requisitions for several athletic court projects. The Greater Model pool, Gardenville Recreation Center, and Curtis Bay Recreation Center are currently in the design phase. The Furley Recreation Center bids have closed, and Baltimore City Schools is in the process of finalizing the award.

### ***Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)***

In January 2023, BCHD released four RFAs, one each for vaccination, testing, communications, and IT. The BCHD Communications Team is developing its comprehensive communications campaign and has begun a series of foundational efforts, including: 1) conducting an audit of the BCHD's COVID-19 website and mapped changes to be implemented to make it easier to navigate, visually compelling, and designed with the campaign's target populations in mind; 2) working with John Hopkins University to conduct focus groups that test different messaging strategies to target populations; 3) conducting internal conversations with BCHD staff about reimplementing canvassing program, this time utilizing professional political campaign best practices including face to face conversations; and 4) working with the Baltimore Banner on a story it is developing about the state of COVID-19 in the City and the efforts of BCHD to continue combatting it. The Communications Team also shared a memo of BCHD's major COVID-19-related accomplishments, facilitated an hour-long interview with the BCHD Commissioner, facilitated a COVID-19 mobile site visit, prepping all potential on-record participants with talking points and message frame, and met with a digital agency to determine if it would be the right fit to help implement our new COVID-19 strategy, specifically related to social media engagement and digital ad campaigns.

Finally, BCHD has continued its ongoing vaccination and testing clinics, and food delivery to homes and congregate senior sites.

### ***Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)***

BDE is partnering with the Office of Statewide Broadband to co-host one of their regional broadband conferences in May 2023. In addition, three recreation centers—James McHenry, Middle Branch, and Solo Gibbs—have been connected to the City’s fiber optic cable network and purchase orders have been issued for thirteen other centers. Finally, BDE is continuing the planning process to launch the Digital Equity Fund grant opportunity.

### ***Department of General Services***

DGS is currently awaiting the delivery of the vehicles in order to perform upfitting to BPD’s specifications.

### ***CASH Campaign - Guaranteed Income Pilot***

In January 2023, CASH Campaign and its evaluation partners issued a 6-month quantitative survey to pilot participants to gather data on the impact of this pilot on the daily lives of participants and their families. An updated version of the original baseline survey, this survey will be active for two months. Also, CASH Campaign has assisted at least 40 participants with establishing bank accounts.

### ***Mayor’s Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)***

MOHS and DHCD are collaboratively working to develop permanent supportive housing for households experiencing homelessness. The Rapid Rehousing contracts have been executed, training has occurred with providers, and referrals are being made to providers for placement.

### ***Mayor’s Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)***

An overview of MONSE’s implementation of ARPA grant awards is as follows:

- MONSE is finalizing funding allocations related to CVI expansion grants and expects to share a proposed funding breakdown within the next two months.
- Victim Services continues to refine its rapid response protocol in partnership with the MONSE Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response Manager. The agency provided community-level presence and support in response to mass shootings, youth-involved shootings, and traumatic incidents in January.
- MONSE issued two award letters to Neighborhood Policing Pilot organizations Fayette Street Outreach and Greater Baybrook Association. The award amounts were based on a rubric MONSE employed to ensure the ask and the community-based organization delivering the ask were in alignment with the community they serve. MONSE’s Finance Team is in the process of preparing the contracts.
- BCPSS requested a no-cost extension for the CFR-related contract for mental health first aid training (BOE approved). Training is expected to be completed by the end of this academic year.
- The GVRs pilot in the Southwestern and Western Districts is ongoing. The MONSE GVRs team is sharing information about the pilot at community association meetings in Southwest Baltimore.

## *Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED)*

Seventeen Train Up Occupational Skills training providers continue to provide services, including 7 funded by City ARPA. All Support Services and Community Connectors contracts and services are in place. A total of 458 participants enrolled in Train Up Occupational Skills Training, of whom 148 are with City ARPA-funded programs. In total (including City and State ARPA funded programs), 212 enrollees have obtained certifications, 268 have completed their training, and 113 have gained employment with an average hourly wage of \$18.43, well above the target of \$15.00. Several program participants are still in training or the job search phase.

A total of 201 unemployed/underemployed Baltimore City residents have received subsidized employment through Hire Up -with about 80 individuals funded by City ARPA. Including State-funded slots, 35 of those who remained in the program for at least two weeks have transitioned to unsubsidized employment, 31 of whom reported an entry wage of \$15/hour or higher. Current worksites include the Baltimore City Department of Transportation, Department of Finance, Baltimore City Recreation and Parks Department, Department of Public Works, Parking Authority of Baltimore City, Downtown Partnership of Baltimore, and the Mayor's Office of African American Male Engagement and MOED. In addition, eleven youth that squeegee completed employment through the Hire Up program in January 2023, and all were offered a permanent unsubsidized position at their worksite, of whom nine accepted.

Hire Up and Train Up Project Managers continue to coordinate with two legal services providers, Maryland Legal Aid and Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service as well as Associated Catholic Charities to provide behavioral health services. At least 47 participants have taken advantage of free legal services. More than 100 residents have attended orientation with Catholic Charities, and 30 have received group or individual behavioral health services.

Through the Small Business Wage Subsidy, a total of 362 unemployed or underemployed residents have been hired at small, minority- or woman-owned businesses, and 260 subsidies have been paid to businesses thus far (paid upon 10 weeks of employment). Of these subsidies, 82 were supported by City ARPA.

The YouthWorks 2023 portal has opened for Baltimore City youth ages 14-21 to register. Youth can register for a summer employment opportunity until April 7th and worksites until April 14th. To date over 4500 youth and 132 worksites have registered online. The 5-week program will operate from July 10th to August 11th. Youthworks Academy begins February 6th and will provide job readiness and pre-employment opportunities to 100 interested youth. Youth Advisory Council begins March 13th and will employ 10 youth as staff advising the YouthWorks team.

The Let's Ride to Work Program, in partnership with Lyft, provides up to 40 rides for newly hired employees working in Baltimore City. Thus far, 156 clients have received a total of 3768 rides.

## *Mayor's Office of Performance and Innovation*

OPI has created materials for their February information and working sessions for the city agency's Performance Planning Launch. Both a performance planning playbook and one pager used to explain to agencies how to create performance plans are included.

OPI also is working with GovEx on a Performance Planning 101 for agencies and approved a syllabus for that training. Agency research was conducted and completed to identify appropriate existing measures in agency budget books. Coordination with BBMR has been ongoing for the Performance Planning Launch.

## Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)/Housing

The inter-agency agreement between MORP and DHCD for the Permitting System Upgrades has been executed. The redesign of DHCD’s permitting process will provide a faster and more efficient system for both internal and external stakeholders. Extensive research, including a public survey (28,000 participants) and a focus group consisting of external users, was created to generate feedback to include in the decision-making process. DHCD will be looking to select a system by late spring.

## Department of Planning (DOP)

**Food Insecurity:** DOP is in the final stages of technology development for its online SNAP fruit and vegetable incentive program. They have been working on developing technology platforms for the incentives for about 5 months and have viewed final versions of these platforms for all three retailers. Additionally, DOP has successfully designed and placed an order for online SNAP educational and promotional materials which will be distributed to city agencies and community members in March 2023.

In partnership with SNAP-Ed, DOP has developed community-facing educational materials, which will be distributed to community members. These materials will be distributed in partnership with the Baltimore City Health Department’s Division of Aging, the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, and various Enoch Pratt Library locations. Materials will be used as educational tools for community members. DOP is also creating training materials to train City agency staff members on online SNAP and the incentive program. Training will be conducted in March through April. Subsequently, trained City employees will be able to provide technical assistance to community members as they navigate the online grocery retail space, online SNAP, and using online SNAP incentives.

Finally, the Food Access Planner and Baltimore Corp fellow have been visiting produce box distribution sites to observe operations.

**Clean Corp:** DOP has provided the first three months of funding, and two grantees held hiring events in the month of January.

The Mayor’s Office held a kickoff event on February 8th to announce the selected grantees and the neighborhoods that will receive the Clean Corp initiative. As the project continues to progress, DOP is working to do a series of community engagement activities including social media posts to promote opportunities for the Clean Corps jobs.
