**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

be the Margaret L. Powell Playground.

BY authority of  
Article 5 - Finance, Property, and Procurement  
Section 20-2  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
name of the playground located at Senator Troy Brailey Easterwood Park is the Margaret L.  
Powell Playground.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
after the date it is enacted.


