

**AMENDMENTS TO COUNCIL BILL 26-0172
(1st Reader Copy)**

Amendment No. 1

{Reverting to current veto provisions.}

On page 1, in line 4, strike “adoption and rejection of ordinances and resolutions, the City’s budget,” and substitute “City’s budget”; and, on that same page, strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13; and, on pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 4 on page 3 through line 28 on page 4, inclusive.

Amendment No. 2

{Eliminate proposal authorizing the City Council to amend the Ordinance of Estimates through conditional appropriation provisions.}

On page 9, in line 25, in each instance, strike the brackets; and, on that same page, in that same line, strike “*INCREASES, ADDITIONS, AND CONDITIONS.*”; and, on page 10, in lines 14 and 17, in each instance, strike the brackets; and, on that same page, strike in their entirety lines 18 through 20, inclusive; and, on page 12, strike beginning with “EXCEPT” in line 30 down through “ARTICLE,” in line 31.

Amendment No. 3

{Eliminate proposal authorizing the City Council to create non-lapsing funds by ordinance.}

On page 1, in line 24, strike “12” and substitute “11”; and, on page 2, in line 5, strike “9, 10, and 11” and substitute “8, 9, and 10”; and, on that same page, in line 15, strike “13” and substitute “12”; and, on page 9, in lines 21 and 22, in each instance, strike the brackets; and, on that same page, strike in their entirety lines 23 and 24; and, on page 10, in line 13, in each instance, strike the brackets; and, on that same page, in that same line, strike “(III), OR (IV)”; and, on page 13, in line 26, strike “ANY NON-LAPSING FUND OR IN”; and, on that same page in line 27, and on page 14 in line 2, in each instance strike “11” and substitute “10”; and, on page 14, strike in their entirety lines 5 through 7, inclusive; and, on that same page, in line 8,

strike “9” and substitute “8”; and, on page 15, in line 17, strike “10” and substitute “9”; and, on page 20, in line 25, strike “11” and substitute “10”; and, on page 21, in line 19, strike “12” and substitute “11”; and, on page 22, in line 10, strike “13” and substitute “12”.

Amendment No. 4

{Revise the date by which the Board of Estimates shall submit to the City Council the proposed Ordinance of Estimates from April 15th to April 30th.}

On page 5, in line 15, strike “15” and substitute “30”.

Amendment No. 5

{Authorize the Planning Commission to submit additional recommendations regarding capital projects to the City Council after the introduction of the Ordinance of Estimates by the Council President. Authorize the City Council to reduce, eliminate, increase, or add amounts to the Ordinance of Estimates as may be requested by the Planning Commission. As may be amended under these provisions, authorizing the City Council to exceed the total amount of the Operating Budget or the Capital Budget as proposed by the Board of Estimates to the City Council.}

On page 6, in line 31, strike “However, no” and substitute “NO”; and, on that same page, after line 35, insert:

“HOWEVER, THE PLANNING COMMISSION MAY SUBMIT ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING CAPITAL PROJECTS TO THE CITY COUNCIL AFTER THE DATE THE ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES IS INTRODUCED BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT BUT BEFORE THE PASSAGE OF THE ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING NEW INFORMATION REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF CERTAIN FUNDS FOR APPROPRIATION.”;

and, on page 10, after line 13, insert:

“(3) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SUBSECTION, BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF ITS MEMBERS, THE CITY COUNCIL MAY INCREASE ITEMS OF APPROPRIATION OR ADD ANY AMOUNT FOR ANY NEW PURPOSE IN THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES AS MAY BE REQUESTED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION UNDER § 3(A) OF THIS ARTICLE.”;

and, on that same page, in line 14, strike “(3)” and substitute “(4)”.

Amendment No. 6

{Amending the effective date of the Resolution.}

On page 28, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 8, inclusive, and substitute:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Sections 1 and 2 of this Resolution shall, upon approval by the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, become fully effective on December 5, 2028.”;

and, on that same page, in line 9, strike “**5.**” and substitute “**4.**”.
