**INTRODUCTION - RPP Area 48 (Riverside)**

**PURPOSE/PLANS** - For the purpose of modifying the hours of applicable parking restrictions for Residential Parking Plan Area 48 (Riverside); reducing the non-permit parking time threshold; establishing an exception to the applicable permit limit; and correcting and conforming related provisions.

**COMMENTS** – Council Bill 23-0346 seeks to modify existing hours of parking to reduce the non-permit parking hours, specifically on Sunday from the existing “No Parking 6PM-7AM” to “No Parking 2PM Sunday to 7PM Monday”. RPP Area 48 within Riverside has significant community involvement and interest, considering the demand for on-street parking within the immediate area.

**AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSTION** – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation foresees no direct operation or fiscal impact resulting from the advancement of the legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Bill 23-0346.
