Local 911 Telephone Fee – Revision

FOR the purpose of revising the local 911 telephone fee; and providing for a special effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 26. 911 Telephone Fee

18 **§ 26-1. Fee imposed.**

In accordance with State Public Safety Article § 1-311, an additional charge of [75¢] \$1 per month is levied and imposed on all current bills rendered for switched local exchange access service, wireless telephone service, or other 911-accessible service within Baltimore City.
