## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –** 2 **Baltimore City Public Schools – \$12,911,344** 3 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the 4 5 amount of \$12,911,344 to Baltimore City Public Schools – Service 352 (Baltimore City Public Schools), to provide funding for a deficit caused by the City's contribution to the 6 development agreement for City Spring Elementary/Middle School; and providing for a 7 special effective date. 8 By authority of 9 Article VI - Board of Estimates 10 Section 8(b)(2)(iii) and (c) 11 **Baltimore City Charter** 12 (1996 Edition) 13 14 Recitals 15 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$12,911,344 in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for 16 Fiscal Year 2025. 17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of 18 19 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated. This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the 20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated or is for a new program that could 21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated. 22 On October 15, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City 23 24 Council.

## Council Bill 25-0105

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$12,911,344 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Public Schools – Service 352
(Baltimore City Public Schools) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for
Fiscal Year 2025, to provide funding for a deficit caused by the City's contribution to the
development agreement for City Spring Elementary/Middle School. The source of revenue for
this appropriation is General Fund assigned Fund Balance in excess of the amount from this
source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
