6	(a) In-term increases or decreases – In general.
7 8 9 10 11	(1) In preparing the Ordinance of Estimates, the Board of Estimates may increase or decrease the salaries of all municipal officers, except[:(i)] FOR the elected officials AND BOARD OF ESTIMATES OFFICIALS WHO ARE subject to Article VII, §§ 117 through 125 of this Charter[; and (ii) the appointed municipal officers who serve as members of the Board of Estimates].
12 13	(2) If the salary of [an appointed] A municipal officer is so increased or decreased, it may not again be increased or decreased, as the case may be, during that officer's term.
14	[(b) In-term increases or decreases – Board members.
15 16	(1) The Mayor and City Council may, by ordinance, increase or decrease the salaries of the appointed municipal officers who serve as members of the Board of Estimates.
17 18 19	(2) If the salary of an appointed municipal officer on the Board is so increased or decreased, it may not again be increased or decreased, as the case may be, during that officer's term.]

7	(1) THE CITY SOLICITOR; AND
8	(2) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS.

10 11	"Commission" means the Compensation Commission for Elected and Board of Estimates Officials.

13 14	"Compensation" means all salary and allowances paid to an elected official OR BOARD OF ESTIMATES OFFICIAL.

9	If, by a majority vote of all members, the City Council affirmatively rejects the
10	Resolution on or before December 15 of the year preceding the mayoral general electio
11	the compensation to be paid elected AND BOARD OF ESTIMATES officials remains
12	unchanged.
13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment to the City
14	Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or
15	rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form
16	specified by the City Solicitor.
