Re: City Council Bill 16-0765 - Disclosure of Industrial and Railroad

Operations - Stand-Alone Disclosure Required

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0765,

If enacted, this bill would make it clear to a buyer of real property, before entering into a contract of sale, that if the property is close to industrial and railroad operations they could experience noises, odors, fumes, bright lights, vibrations, and/or safety hazards. The bill would require the existing disclosure on Industrial and Railroad Operations to be a separate, stand-alone page that would require the buyer's signature.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 16-0765.
