15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22	Beginning for the same at a point on the northeasterly side of Hurley Avenue, 33 feet wide, as shown on Baltimore City Plat File Nos. 100-B-40, 248-A-7A & 132-A-1D the point being distant North 28° 51' 24" West 184.21 feet from the intersection formed by the northerly side of Wilkens Avenue 100 feet wide, and the northeasterly side of Hurley Avenue; thence departing the point so fixed and binding on and running with the northerly side of Hurley Avenue by the following 2 courses and distances, with all bearings herein being referred to the Baltimore City Coordinate System as now surveyed:
23	(1) North 28° 51' 24" West for a distance of 11.47 feet to a point; and thence:
24 25 26	(2) North 33° 06' 50" West for a distance of 3.54 feet to a point; thence departing Hurley Avenue and running through Lot 2 of "Lower Gwynn's Falls Park" by the following 8 courses and distances
