Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 10-0598 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would grant a franchise to Apex Oil Company (“Grantee”), to construct, use, and maintain, at Grantee’s own expense, a private fuel pipeline under and across a portion of Frankfurst Avenue right-of-way, connecting facilities located on the properties known as NuStar – LP Terminal pier and Center Point Terminal on Vera Street, and provide for a special effective date.

The bill is in accordance with Article VIII of the Baltimore City Charter. The Law Department therefore approves City Council Bill 10-0598 for form and legal sufficiency.
