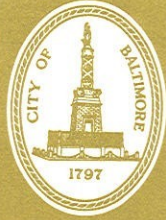

Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill # 10-619 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the
Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of this legislation is to renew and continue the Waterfront
Management District and Waterfront Management Authority; providing for a special
effective date; and generally relating to the activities and authority of the Waterfront
Management District and Waterfront Management Authority.

The Waterfront Management District is bounded by Key Highway to the
southwest, Light Street to the west, Pratt Street to the north, President, Fleet, Central,
Aliceanna, Caroline and Thames Streets to the east and the waterfront opposite those
boundaries.

The BMZA has reviewed this legislation and the report of the Planning
Commission. The Board of Municipal and Zoning appeals has no objection to the
passage of City Council Bill No. 10-0619.


