SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That permission is [hereby] granted to [South Baltimore Homeless Shelter, Inc.,] BALTIMORE OUTREACH SERVICES for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a home for homeless women and children on the property known as 701 S. Charles Street, as outlined in red on the plats accompanying this [ordinance] Ordinance, [under the provisions of Sections 6-5-1d-1 and 11.0-6d of Article 30 of the Baltimore City Code (1983 Replacement Volume, as amended) titled "Zoning"] IN ACCORDANCE WITH BALTIMORE CITY ZONING CODE §§ 6-609(1) AND 14-102, subject to the FOLLOWING conditions [that]:

1. [the] THE home [shall be in operation only from November 1, to April 30, each year, and that it shall] MAY house no more than 50 persons at [one] ANY time.
