The Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD) is pleased to have the opportunity to review City Council Bill #19-0451, entitled "Biennial Comprehensive Crime Reduction Plan." This bill would require the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ) to develop, in conjunction with several different agencies, a biennial comprehensive crime reduction plan. BCHD advocates for a "health in all policies" approach to all systemic issues faced by our City's residents. In constructing its comprehensive crime reduction plan, BCHD would assist MOCJ in incorporating a focus on the social determinants of health, specifically touching upon BCHD's work regarding social supports, access to health care services, and exposure to crime, violence, and social disorder. Altogether, while BCHD welcomes the opportunity for further collaboration with MOCJ, BCHD defers to MOCJ with respect to the construction of a comprehensive crime reduction plan and takes **no position** on Council Bill #19-0451.
