 - Need dedicated funding
 - Transparency, allocation and accountability are needed
 - Need effective outcomes
 - Community is resilient
 - More community input and engagement are needed

 - Question(s)
 - When is the next LGBTQ meeting? Answer: Second Tuesday in each month. – <u>Also see committee request below</u>.

 - How many of our city partners go through actual training?
 - o Comments:
 - To the community: "We (Council) will protect you!
 - The Council is committed to all communities in the City!
 - Baltimore is a welcoming City to all people and is proud of same!
 - Baltimore protects its people! And is upholding our commitment to equity.
 - We want to make sure we are doing the things we are saying we are doing!
