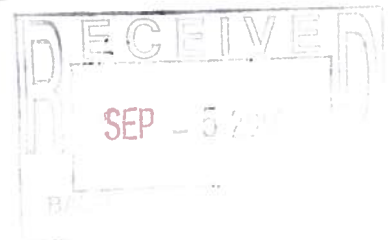
Therefore, the Department of Recreation and Parks **supports** Council Bill 14-0408.
