15	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$1,773,000 from the Opioid		
16 17	Restitution Fund in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.		
18	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of		
19	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.		
20	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the		
21	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated or is for a new program that could		
22	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.		
23	On December 18, 2024, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City		
24	Council.

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$1,773,000 shall be made available to the Mayoralty – Service 918 (Opioid Restitution
3	Administration) as a Supplementary Special Revenue Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal
4	Year 2025, to provide funding for additional positions to provide direction and guidance
5	regarding the City's opioid response, establishment of the Restitution Advisory Board,
6	contractual support to establish a trust fund for litigation proceeds, and community engagement.
7	The source of revenue for this appropriation is \$1,773,000 from the Opioid Restitution Fund in
8	excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in
9	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
