City Council Bill #17-0126 was created for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcel of land known as a portion of the former bed of a 4-foot alley, extending from West Eager Street southerly 75 feet to the property outline known as 13/15 West Eager Street, and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The property is described as a parcel formed by the intersection of the south side of West Eager Street 66 feet wide, and the center of a 4-foot alley measured along the south side of West Eager Street to the west side of Morton Street, containing 149 square feet.

Since this property is no longer needed for public use, and there were no objections from various city agencies to declare the property as surplus, and since there is not a significant fiscal impact, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 17-0126.
