I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 08-0128.


City Streets – Closing – 2 10-foot Alleys

For the purpose of condemning and closing (1) a 10-foot alley laid out in the rear of the property known as No. 2320/2340 N. Calvert Street and (2) a 10-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as Nos. 111 and 113 E. 24th Street, as shown on Plat 346-A-61A in the Office of the Department of Public Works; and providing for a special effective date.

This bill condemns and closes two (2) 10 foot alleys to allow for the incorporation of the properties into a development site. The property bounded by the alleys is currently used for surface parking. The proposed development is an apartment building with off-street parking.

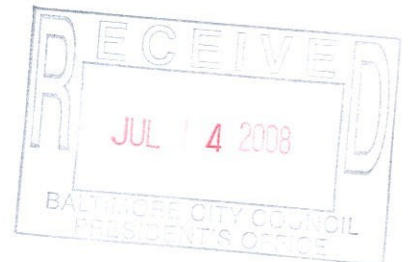
The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of this bill.
