AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation –
M-R Office of Employment Development – Service 795
(Workforce Services for Baltimore Residents) – \$1,375,655**

FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$1,375,655 to the M-R Office of Employment Development – Service 795 (Workforce Services for Baltimore Residents), to provide funding for case management, barrier removal, supportive services, and skills training to workers dislocated by the Francis Scott Key Bridge collapse, as well as offering occupational skills training to prepare workers to assist with disaster recovery efforts and, eventually, the reconstruction of the bridge; and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents ~~federal funds~~ a grant from the Maryland Department of Labor in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

That funding grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.

On February 19, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.



1 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
2 \$1,375,655 shall be made available to the M-R Office of Employment Development – Service
3 795 (Workforce Services for Baltimore Residents) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating
4 Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to provide funding for case management, barrier removal,
5 supportive services, and skills training to workers dislocated by the Francis Scott Key Bridge
6 collapse, as well as offering occupational skills training to prepare workers to assist with disaster
7 recovery efforts and, eventually, the reconstruction of the bridge. The source of revenue for this
8 appropriation is ~~federal funding~~ a grant from the Maryland Department of Labor in excess of the
9 amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
10 required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

11 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
12 enacted.




