1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Zoning – Conditional Use Repeal –**  
3 **2926 Harford Road**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the conditional use (non-profit home for rehabilitation of alcoholics  
5 and care of homeless) previously authorized for 2926 Harford Road; and providing for a  
6 special effective date.

7 BY repealing  
8 Ordinance 03-594  
9 (Approved August 14, 2003)

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
11 Ordinance 03-594, and all conditional uses granted by it and by its predecessor, Ordinance  
12 85-510, for 2926 Harford Road are repealed.

13 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
14 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
15 Ordinance.

16 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it  
17 is enacted.
